Project Teen will be doing another one November 2nd, we are registered to do that one in Santa Maria. Friday October 19th went in and talked to five Health Classes. Might reach out to World Service and ask what they would do because we can't help addicts out of state as much. People calling out of state frustrated because we can't help them.
