- Clearance Process : due to limited budgetary constraints they can not perform unlimited live-scans, as such we must be selective with those applicants we have them pick up the cost of this for. For more applicant opportunities an applicant can bring their own live-scan. After submitting live-scan and application all approved candidates will be required to attend an orientation via zoom. For those applicants we send to the academy for their live-scan they will go onto the base

for this.

- Will need two women and two men for each 10 week cadet classes. It is asked we keep with the same volunteer for each stretch as much as possible while not a deal breaker should we need another volunteer to fill in for a week here or there.
- Facility would like us to begin our first stretch Mid January to beginning of February 2025.
- Meetings will be held on Tuesdays from 16:10HRS to 17:25HRS (4:10PM to 5:25PM).
- Due to the nature of this facility volunteers may notice on site staff counselors coming in to observe meetings occasionally.
- At the end of each 10 week cadet class cadets fill out surveys on all programs they attended. This is non negotiable as part of the academy being able to better their structured time for cadets. i.e. what stays and what doesn't.
