Vice Treasurer is 3 years clean and will need to submit some information about your identity to be put on the bank account once they become treasurer. RCM's 3 years clean willingness and ability to drive to the quarterly RSC meeting, gas is covered at \$.70/per mile traveled. Literature secretary can be done via Zoom but the Literature clerk must be able to travel to ASC. Both commitments require 6 months clean. PR needs a Literature Liaison with 6 months clean which is being worked on through Area PR.
